

## 2017 Canadian Stroke Congress Presenter Guidelines Digital Display Posters

All presenters **MUST register** for the Canadian Stroke Congress, and complete a **Declaration of Conflict of Interest Form**.

### Digital Display Poster

Digital Display Posters will be coordinated through our Abstract Management Administrators. You will submit your digital poster to OWPM, who will ensure that your digital poster is uploaded and available for presentation on site at its assigned digital poster station.

### Instructions for Preparing Digital Posters

All posters will be displayed in digital format only on high-resolution monitors in the Exhibit Hall of the 2017 Canadian Stroke Congress.

The deadline to submit your Digital Poster is 1600 hrs Pacific Time  
on **Friday, September 1, 2017**  
There will be no extensions to this deadline.

No changes to digital posters will be allowed after this date.

### Creating and Designing Your Digital Poster

All posters will be displayed on 55 inch screens and must be set in landscape orientation (i.e., horizontal orientation) utilizing 16:9 ratio. All information (i.e. text, data, photos and figures) must be designed to appear within one window. It will NOT be possible to display poster content over multiple pages/slides.

Do NOT embed videos or animation within your poster as these will not be supported.

Digital posters will be accepted and displayed in **PDF Format only**.
