

2017 Canadian Stroke Congress Presenter Guidelines Paper & Digital Display Posters

All presenters **MUST register** for the Canadian Stroke Congress, and complete a **Declaration of Conflict of Interest Form**.

Digital Display Poster

Digital Display Posters will be coordinated through our Abstract Management Administrators. You will submit your digital poster to OWPM, who will ensure that your digital poster is uploaded and available for presentation on site at its assigned digital poster station.

Paper Posters

Paper Posters will be displayed in the Exhibit Hall (Exhibit Hall C, Calgary TELUS Convention Centre) for all Congress attendees to view from Saturday, September 9th (10:30 am) through to Sunday, September 10th (3:30 pm). Poster presenters are asked to visit the Exhibit Hall **between 7:30 and 9:30 am on Saturday, September 9th** to hang their poster in advance of the opening of the Exhibit Hall at 10:00 am.

Paper Posters will be displayed in their respective streams (Acute & Prevention, Rehabilitation, Health Systems, Nursing or Basic Biomedical). Each poster will be assigned a poster board number. Please refer to the Program APP to obtain the poster board number, and ensure the poster is hung on the assigned poster board.

All paper poster presenters are asked to be by their posters during the Exhibit Hall Reception from **5:00 to 6:30 pm on Saturday, September 9th** to engage in dialogue with fellow delegates.

ALL Posters are to remain on the boards in the Exhibit Hall until 3:30 pm on Sunday, September 10th. We ask all paper poster presenters to visit the Exhibit Hall after the Sunday afternoon break to take down their poster.

Poster Size – All Paper posters MUST BE 44in x 44in or 111.76 x 111.76 cm MAXIMUM in size.

There will be four posters assigned to each board (two per side). Posters larger than the requested size above will not fit on the poster boards and therefore will not be displayed. Push pins will be available to secure the posters to the boards.
